St Mary's has had a long association with the Food Bank MK going back many years. Donations are needed now, perhaps more than ever. The need is there, and is con-

tinuing to grow, so please think about donating an item or two from your weekly shop. You can bring your donations to the service at St Mary's Church, Woburn for delivery on a regular basis.

Items most needed change from time to time, and you can always check this on the MK Foodbank website, but currently they are asking for: Tinned Meat, Tinned Fish, Long Life Milk, Juice or Squash, Cooking Oil, Spreads – Jams, Peanut Butter, or Chocolate Spread, Tinned Pasta, Pasta Sauce, Tinned Fruit, Dried Rice – 500g, Tinned Veg, Dried Pasta, Tinned Soups, Savoury Snacks/ Cereal Bars, Toiletries

The Benefice also has a new food donation box in the porch of St John's, Eversholt, where food can be dropped off at any time. Donations here will go to the Need Project, another food bank in Central Beds that we are keen to support.
